# Youngsters Lead Out 541 Angus At National Show

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind. — Young Angus breeders from 24 states and Canada led out a top quality set of 541-head of registered Angus cattle at this year's, 19th National Junior Angus Show here at the state fairgrounds.

Judge for the breeding cattle show was Pete Sweeney, Mason, Michigan. He placed a total of 455 Angus in the bred-and-owned heifers, owned heifers (heifers owned but not bred by the exhibitor), bred-and-owned bulls and cow/ calf pairs divisions. Dr. Doug Parrett, Urbana, Illinois, judged the 86-head Registered Angus Steer Show.

Amy Ostrom, 18, Loganville, Georgia, was one happy exhibitor, as she showed the grand champion bred-and-owned heifer. Shiloh Edella G63 earlier was named the intermediate winner of the 122-head division. This heifer is a June 1986 daughter of Cobble Pond New Yorker.

The reserve grand champion bred-and-owned heifer banner went to the junior champ, Fox Hill Blackbirds Babe. This heifer is owned by Chris Jordan, 12, Kennett Square, and is a January 1986, Kruegers Foolish Pride daughter.

The limelight in the 306-head 'owned' heifer category shown on Ryan Cotton, 17, Howell, Michigan, and his grand champion entry, Piper Camilla P602. Also named the early junior champion, this heifer was born January 1986 and was sired by Cobble Pond New Yorker.

John Bell, 18, Georgetown, Kentucky, took home the reserve grand champion 'owned' heifer banner. Playful Lass 546 also won the late junior champion title. She is an April 1986 daughter of Brost Power Drive.

Grand champion bred-andowned bull laurels went to a November 1986 son of Waldeck Shocker. Dameron Jolt also stood as the bull calf champion and is owned by Jeff Dameron, 15, Lexington, Illinois.

Rance Long, 16, Sherwood, Maryland, was directed to the reserve grand champion bred-andowned bull spot with his entry, Destinations East Wind. Judge Sweeney also awarded him with the intermediate ribbon. This bull is a May 1986 son of J K Pine Tar.

Ryan Cotton took hom another championship banner. He exhibited the grand champion cow/calf pair. The cow, Premier Venus was named the grand champion bredand-owned heifer at the 1985 National Junior Angus Show. She has January bull calf at her side, sired by Harrison.

Jay Cat Diamond Ballou and her February, Genetics Madison Avenue bull calf, shown by Rachel Smith, 14, Hiawatha, Kansas, won the reserve grand champion cow/ calf banner.

In the Registered Angus Steer Show, judge Parrett slapped Stewarts Overdrive 683B as his grand champion. Shown by Jackie Riecke, 14, Avilla, Indiana, this steer is an April 1986 son of Ken Caryl Overdrive 304H. He weighed 1,238 pounds and had a weight per day of age of 2.69 pounds.

Teri Walsh, 18, Mineral Point, Wisconsin, led her 1,278 pound entry to the reserve grand champion steer spot. S V F General

Chris Jordan, Kennett Square, exhibited the reserve grand champion bredand-owned heifer at the 19th National Junior Angus Show held July 7-11 at the state fairgrounds in Indianapolis, Indiana. Fox Hill Blackbirds Babe also won the lunior champion ribbon at the 541-head show. Pete Sweeney, Mason, Michigan, served as Judge.

George 6478 was born March 1986 and is a son of S V F General George. He had a weight per day of age of 2.71 pounds.

In the carcass show, Doug Spooner, 17, Evansville, Wisconsin, exhibited the grand champion. His July 1986, M T F Big Guy 844 son weighed 1,095 pounds; had a weight per day of age of 2.99 pounds; a hot carcass weight of 711 pounds; graded low choice; and had a 2.6 yield grade.

The reserve grand champion carcass was entered by Andrew Hooten, Gays, Illinois. His March 1986 son of Ken Caryl Overdrive 304H son weighed 1,370 pounds;

had a weight per day of age of 2.93 pounds; a hot carcass weight of 882 pounds; graded low choice; and had a 3.1 yield grade,

For the second year in a row, Amy Ostrom earned the Premier Breeder Award. It is presented to the breeder of the three highest


