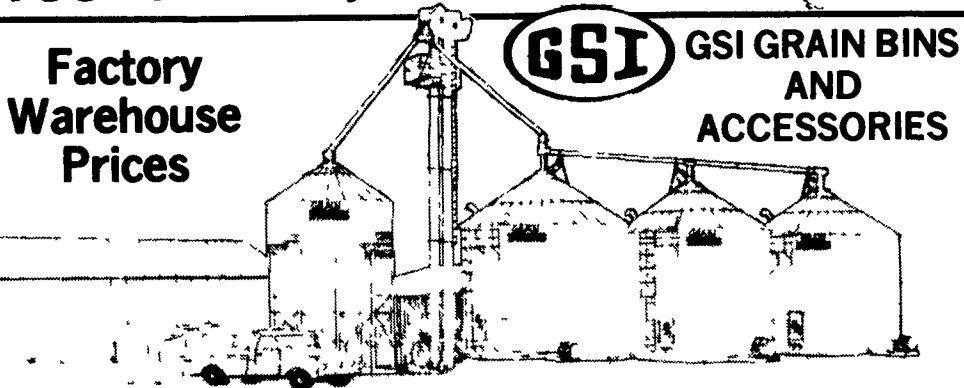
The past president's plaque was presented to Larry Redding, who also recognized his high school principal, Robert M. Reed, for cooperation received during the year.

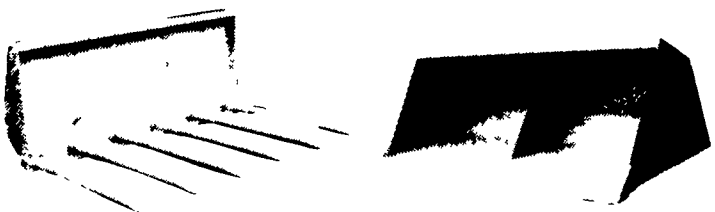
