can Farm Bureau Federation, a 3.5 million member farm organization, and is available in Pennsylvania through the Pennsylvania Farmers' Association (PFA). ACRES improves marketing potential by giving subscribers access to a computerized database of constantly

updated market news including commodity prices, marketing advice and USDA reports.
