

Western Holstein Champion Show

"The most I can say about the grand champion today is that she was sired by the son of the grand champion cow at the first championship show right here 15 years ago," said Ed Doeberiener of Jamestown.

Doeberiener claimed premier exhibitor for his Queens-Manor holsteins at the 15th Western Pennsylvania Holstein Championship Show held July 31, 1987. He is also part owner of the grand champion.

It was August 7, 1973, when the

first championship show was held in Pennsylvania. And this year it returned to its origin Mercer County 4-H Park.

It was in '73 that C. Roselandvale Echo Pat entered by David Floch of Jamestown was named champion. '87 C. Feederlane Patriot Dolly sired by Floch Farms Patriot (twin) became champion. "Dolly" owned by Queens-Manor, James Siedel and Donald Green, experienced a near miracle. Six weeks after calving she was down for six days. She has been up just three weeks and was scored 87 points on July 21st. "We're fortunate we didn't lose her," claimed

Doeberiener. "It appears the royal treatment she was given paid off."

The first place four year old was given the honor by Judge Dave Bachman, national director of the Holstein Association in Sheboygan, Wisconsin. He is also the owner of Pinehurst and Lakehurst Holsteins. Les Firth, Mercer County agent, said that Bachman praised the extreme high quality seen at this size of show.

Morrell Farms of Cochranon claimed reserve grand champion, aged cow, best three females and best bred and owned classes to garner premier breeder honors. Bob Morrell explained that the first

place aged cow named reserve grand champion Ebe-Tide Triple Threat Flora (twin) EX91 was a member of the All Pennsylvania Produce in 1986. All 10 animals Morrells exhibited were home bred. Morrells are well known for their fine breeding and for the first time one premier breeder at the state show this spring.

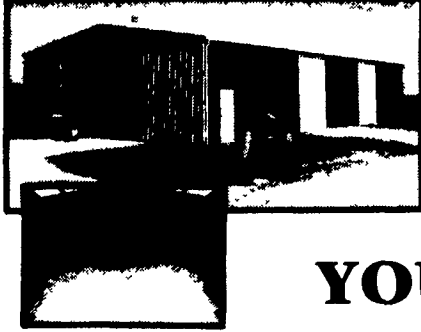

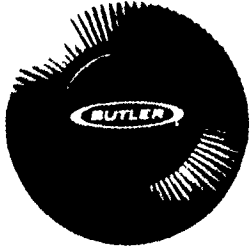

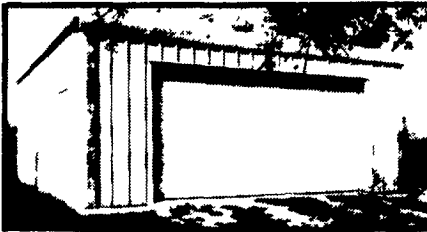
