Grand Champion honors went

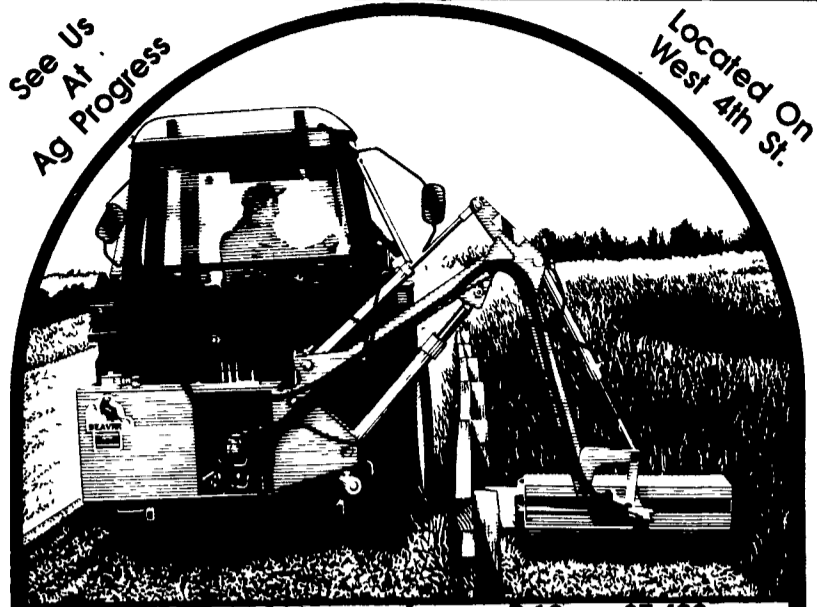

also captured junior champion with her junior doe kid, while Jennifer Seber took reserve junior champion with her senior doe kid.

The showmanship and fitting contest was divided into three categories based on age of exhibitor. The senior section was for 4-H members 14 years of age or older. The senior showmanship honors were taken by Jennifer Seber, while Betsy Aronson, won senior fitting honors. In the junior showmanship and fitting contest, which is for 4-H members 8-13 years old, Laura Carmean, Schwenksville, took top showmanship honors, while her sister Wanda Carmean, Schwenksville, to top fitting honors.

In the first year fitting and showmanship competition, which is designed specifically for first year members, William Mathews of New London took top showmanship honors, while Laura Anderson of Landenberg, took top fitting honors.
