

206-Head Shown At Angus Show

The competition proved to be tough at the 40th showing of the American Angus Breeders' Futurity as some of the best Angus breeding cattle from across the United States were contesting for the number one spot of supreme champion. The 206-head of bulls, heifers and cow/calf pairs display-

ed received their placings from Mark Richardson, Milton, Indiana, judge of the event.

This year's show was dedicated to the late Floyd Dievert of Danville, Kentucky.

Broadway, for the second year in a row, was awarded with the supreme champion banner. Owned

by R&J Ranch, Briggs, Texas; Springfield Angus Farm, Louisville, North Carolina; and Lee Miller and Family, Woodsboro, Maryland, he also captured the senior and grand champion bull ribbons. This two-year-old son of Cobble Pond New Yorker entered the show ring weighing 2,446

pounds.

The championship limelight shown upon Class Act R F in the 135-head heifer show. This January 1986, Harrison daughter also won the early junior champion female ribbon for her owners Riverside Farms, Hamilton, Texas, and Premier Angus Inc., Cloverdale, Indiana.

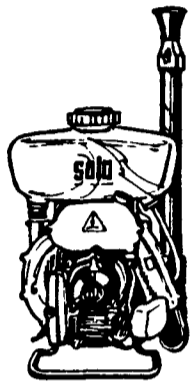
For reserve grand champion bull, judge Richardson went to his reserve senior champ and awarded
