FUTURES MARKET TRENDS GRAIN AND LIVESTOCK

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SOYBEAN ACRES UPDATE: Soybeans settled mixed, with new crop strength focused on tight supplies in the face of steady demand. The August option closed up 5-1/4 cents at \$5.24-3/4. Deferreds closed lower, but well off session lows with losses tied to yesterday's bearish crop report (below). Strength in the nearbys and soymeal helped support the new crop months after a sharply lower opening. The November

option lost 3 cents at \$4.98, while the January lost 4-3/4 cents, settling at \$5.02-1/2.

ACRES WHEAT UPDATE: Wheat futures settled higher and

near the session highs for the third day on a late short covering rally. Losses earlier in the session were tied to reaction from yesterday's supply and demand report which cut USSR 1987 Grain import estimates and the weakness from the soybean and corn pits. Wheat/ Corn spreads and expectations for a brighter export picture strengthed prices. December closed up 3/4 cent at \$2.84-1/4.

ACRES CATTLE UPDATE: After a surprise turnaround live cattle and feeders settled higher after a disappointing lackluster session. Gains in the feeders late in the session were sparked by ideas
