He was joined by other family members and Teresa's boy friend, and eventually Teresa caved in and entered. Now she's glad she did. Cheryl chose not to enter.

"I found out it is more of a worthwhile thing. If it had been strictly a beauty contest, I never would have entered," Teresa says. Indeed, the role she is least looking forward to is riding floats in the county fair parades.

The part she is most eager to undertake is "talking with people and getting to meet people." She is eager to tell of the benefits of using poultry products, saying, "Eggs are the best source of animal protein, and are economical and nutritional. They are also easy to prepare."
