

## Wayne Co. Junior Livestock Sale

Thomas Thiede & Son, Forest City, purchased the Grand Champion steer at the Junior Livestock Sale last Saturday evening at the Wayne County Fair for \$1.50 per pound or a total of \$1,747.50. The 1,165 pound steer was raised by Julie Rutledge, Tyler Hill. Milon's Garage purchased the Grand Champion pig, which was raised by Tom Billard, Honesdale, for \$4.75 per pound or a total of \$1,026.00. The Grand Champion lamb, raised by Patrick Mang, Honesdale, was purchased by Marshall Machinery Inc., Honesdale, for \$6.25 per pound or a total of \$768.75.

Taylor Packing, Wyalusing, purchased the Reserve Grand Champion steer for \$0.95 per pound or a total of \$1,068.75. The 1,125 pound steer was raised by Shane Fuller, Damascus. The Reserve Grand Champion pig, raised by Nathan Gries, Milanville, was purchased by Thomas Thiede, Forest City, for \$2.25 per pound. Thomas Thiede also purchased the Reserve Grand Champion lamb, raised by Amy Burlein, Honesdale, for \$3.75 per pound.

One hundred thirty-nine 4-H animals sold for a total of \$45,809.00 which is \$1,030 above last year's total sale receipts. Total live weight produced and sold was 43,147 pounds. Average prices for each species were: steers, \$0.86 per pound; pigs, \$1.14 per pound; and lambs, \$1.75 per pound. Excluding the Grand and Reserve Grand Champions the averages were: steers, \$0.81 per pound; pigs, \$1.08 per pound; and lambs, \$1.57 per pound.

The top volume buyer for the sale was Thomas Thiede & Son who purchased 6 pigs, 4 lambs, and 10 steers for a total value of \$11,686.65.

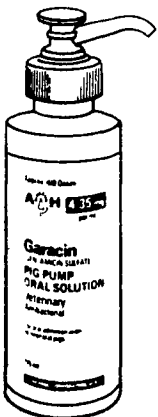

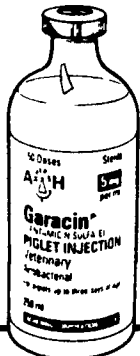

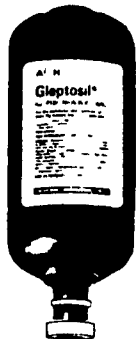
