

# Annual Thurmont & Emmitsburg Community Show

This year marks the 31st anniversary of the Thurmont and Emmitsburg Community Show, scheduled for Friday, Saturday and Sunday, September 11, 12 and 13, 1987 at Catoctin High School.

Over 2500 farm and garden, household, quilt, livestock and machinery displays can be seen during the 3 day event.

Each year the Community Show honors an organization for its contributions to community life. This year the show will be honoring the Guardian Hose Company of Thurmont on its 100th anniversary.

The show opens Friday, September 11, 6 p.m. to the public. At 7:45 p.m. the Catoctin High School Band will render several selections in the auditorium followed by the massing of flags by community civic organizations. Special recognition will be given to the Guardian Hose Company at this time. Highlight of the program will be the announcement of the 1987-88 Catoctin FFA Chapter Sweetheart by a representative of the Hose Company.

Following the program at 9 p.m., an auction of all baked goods exhibited at the show will be held in the auditorium.

Saturday's activities include a pet show beginning at 10 a.m. and a Beef, Sheep and Swine Fitting and Showing also at 10 a.m.

At 3 p.m. the Thurmont Grange

will serve a turkey and ham supper in the school cafeteria.

Throughout the day the Guardian Hose Company will present several demonstrations and music will be provided by the Catoctin Mountain Boys. The Catoctin

Area FFA Alumni Beef, Sheep and Swine Sale will be held in the Ag Center Area, 7 p.m.

Sunday, September 13, the show opens at 12 noon with a Chicken Bar-B-Que served by the Catoctin FFA Alumni.

"Dash For Mash" pig and duck races will be held at 1, 2, 3 and 4 p.m.

A mule pulling contest begins at 1:30 p.m. along with music by the Catoctin Mountain Boys. Fire company demonstrations continue

throughout the day.

The Community Show is sponsored by the Thurmont and Emmitsburg Granges, Catoctin FFA Chapter, Catoctin Area FFA Alumni and the Maryland Agricultural Fair Board.

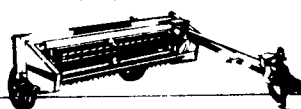

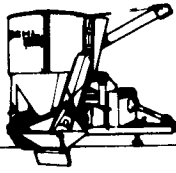

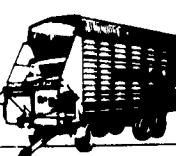
