

Delaware County 4-H Livestock Show

Delaware County 4-H members sold fifteen hogs and seven lambs at auction, following their show at the Delaware County 4-H Fair on Saturday, August 15 at the 4-H Center in Rose Tree Park, Media. The fifteen hogs, sold by the head and not by the pound, brought a record total of \$5140.00 an average of \$342.67 per hog. The champion market hog, a crossbred Duroc barrow shown by David Trumbull of Lima sold for \$475 to Culbertson Enterprises, Inc. of West Chester, according to C.R. Bryan, Jr., Delaware County 4-H Agent. The reserve champion shown by Kerry Boody of Newtown Square was purchased by

S.K. Kelso Sons Plasters, Inc. of Newtown Square. The champion market lamb was a Dorset shown by Chris Young of Clifton Heights and sold to Hearn Calloway of Calloway Florists in Brookhaven. Mary Beth Miller of Havertown had the reserve champion lamb which sold to Jenny Campbell of Bryn Mawr.

In the showmanship competition the members are judged on how they present their animals to the judge, who was Keith Bryan of State College, Pa. Champion senior hog showman was Stephen Harman and reserve champion was David Trumbull, both of Lima. Champion junior hog showman

was Matt Trumbull of Lima and reserve champion was Chris Boody of Newtown Square. Champion first year lamb showmanship was won by Bryan Haskins of Aston and reserve champion by Mary Beth Miller of Havertown. The experienced lamb showmanship champion was Josh Young of Clifton Heights and the reserve was Chris Young of Aston. Other members who showed lambs were Mickey Hess of Middletown Township and Jimmy Harris of Wallingford. Others showing hogs were Julie Hoppe of Secane, Barbar Hannig of Broomall, Aaron and Katherine

Andrewson of Havertown, Matt Cartwright of Middletown and Josh Young of Clifton Heights.

In the 4-H Dairy Show the Dairy Goat Championships were swept by Candice Blose of Moylan. Heather Fowler of Bryn Mawr, and Mindy Murray of Morton also received champion ribbons and

Plan A Farm Shop

UNIVERSITY PARK — Do you need a dry, safe place to store tools, parts, and materials which are needed for maintenance projects? Perhaps you already have a sound building available to remodel into a farm shop or a handicraft establishment. The booklet Planning Farm Shops, has information useful for rural residents with hobbies and farmers with continuous repairs.

One guideline is to have the shop twice the width of the largest access door and at least as long as it is wide. Other helpful information includes sections about building

design, space requirements, material storage, equipment, power and hand tool specifications, shop safety and utilities such as lighting, heating, plumbing, shop hoists and ventilation. In addition, equipment templates with adjacent work space are included to help you plan a convenient shop layout.

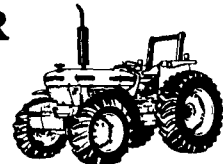
