WASHINGTON, D.C. — Top editors and broadcasters across the nation recently received a wooden cheese cutting board, complete with a pound of real cheddar cheese, from the National Dairy Board. The mailing was part of the Board's continuing effort to draw attention to the dairy industry and increase media awareness of the National Dairy Board.

The cutting board, emblazoned with the National Dairy Board's logo, whetted the appetites of 200 members of the national media, and encouraged them to include dairy-related stories in their publi-

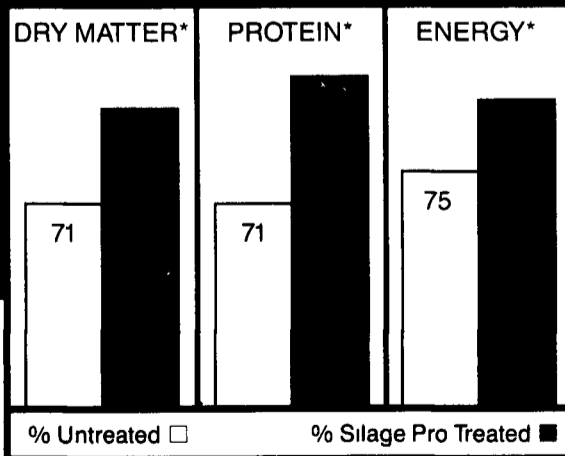

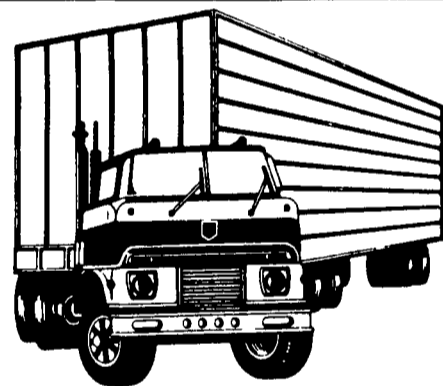
