
The champion Yorkshire boar was exhibited by Charles Hall of Julian. The boar was purchased by William Herring of Schuylkill Haven.



The champion and reserve of the Yorkshire market hogs was purchased from Steve Wilson by William Schaeffer of Lewistown.




Steve Wilson's champion Yorkshire bred gilt from New Freedom was sold to Frank Feeser of Taneytown, Md.




Smith's Hog Farm exhibited this champion Duroc open gilt which sold to Glenn Ebersole of Duncannon.
