

## Northumberland No-Till Meeting To Be Held

SUNBURY — Northumberland County Conservation District and the Cooperative Extension Service will sponsor a twilight meeting on Tuesday, September 8, from 6:30 to 9:20 PM.

The meeting will begin with an inspection of a no-till corn demonstration plot from 6:30 to 7:00 PM. The plot was planted by Donald Cotner and is located in Rushtown

Place, about two miles south of Riverside.

Starting at 7 PM, the rest of the meeting will be held indoors at Cotner's farm. Presentations will be made by chemical company and agency representatives on a variety of topics.

Ted Huhn, Sandoz Corporation, will speak on controlling broadleaf weeds and Steve Fisher, FMC, will

discuss insect control. Workshop participants are encouraged to bring specimens of problem insects to the meeting for identification and discussion of control measures.

County agents Vernon Brose and Norman Conrad will speak on farm chemical safety and protecting groundwater from contamination, respectively. Mark Deibler, Bureau of Forestry, will speak on timber harvesting and woodlot

management. George Phillips of the conservation district staff will present a slide program on the results of the conservation district's no-till demonstration plot program. Robert Jacobs of the conservation district staff will speak on the Chesapeake Bay cost-share program.

The meeting has been approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture as an update training session for pesticide certifica-

tion renewal for private applicators. Private applicators will receive three credits (one core and two subject matter) toward certification renewal.

Refreshments will be provided by the Northumberland County Conservation District. More information on the meeting can be obtained by calling the conservation district office at 988-4224.

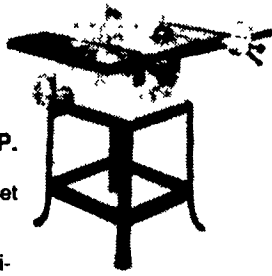

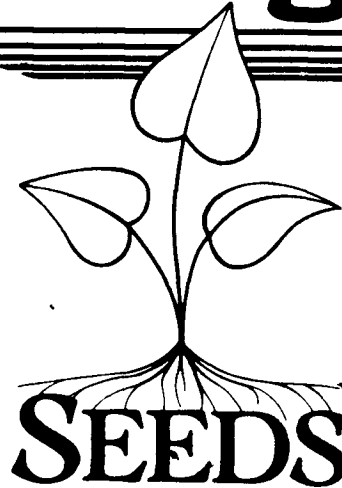

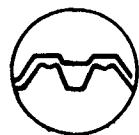
