COUDERSPORT (Potter Co.) — Fifty-four farmers and wives from Lehigh County recently toured potato farms and other points of interest in Potter County. The Lehigh County group first toured the Barnett Brothers Farm at Coudersport RD#1, with particular emphasis on the potato fields and how the Barnetts rogue and grow seed. They visited the Kosa Farm at Ulysses next and toured the shop where the Kosa's make some of the equipment used on their potato and dairy farm, as well as examining the storage facilities. The group arrived back in Coudersport late afternoon where they toured the Potter County Historical Society with members of the society acting as tourguides and answering questions about the artifacts stored there. The evening meal was at Potato City Motor Inn, Coudersport R.D.,

where Ron Brenneman of International Paper Company showed slides of Potter County and the wildlife of the area. The next day the group toured the Irish Farm, Coudersport R.D.#, where they saw a number of varie-

ty trails. They then left for the Pennsylvania Lumber Museum where they saw the tools and equipment used in the early logging heyday of Potter County and had lunch served by the Pennsylvania Lumber Museum Associates before department from Lehigh County.
