THE "CATTLE ON FEED" REPORT AND DECLINES IN DRESSED BEEF CHANNELS, BOTH CARCASS AND BOXED BEEF. HOWEVER, BUYER DEMAND CONTINUED GOOD THROUGHOUT THE PERIOD AS MOST PACKERS WERE ADDING TO THEIR IMMEDIATE SLAUGHTER NEEDS.

SLAUGHTER COWS AND BULLS CLOSED THE WEEK UNDER GOOD BUYER DEMAND. COWS 1.00-2.00 HIGHER THAN LAST WEEK, BULLS 2.00-4.00 HIGHER.

ESTIMATED 5 DAY RECEIPTS THIS WEEK 7,100 COMPARED TO ACTUALS THE PREVIOUS HOLIDAY SHORTENED WEEK OF 3,886 AND ACTUALS LAST YEAR OF 6,573. SLAUGHTER STEERS ACCOUNTED FOR 38 PERCENT OF THE WEEK'S RECEIPTS, SLAUGHTER HEIFERS 36 PERCENT, SLAUGHTER COWS 4 PERCENT AND FEEDER CATTLE 20 PERCENT.

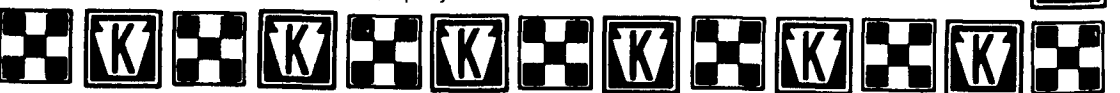
