previously approved \$1.8 million appropriation for facility planning. That makes a total of direct cash contribution of \$18 million to PSU from the federal government for new facilities. In addition, matching funds almost to that level were provided in Pennsylvania's 1986-1987 Capital Budget. "So we have a certainty of new facilities of \$36 to \$37 million for the college of agriculture," Jordan said.

Besides the new agricultural and science facility, the funds will provide for a new poultry research farm, remodeled dairy and swine research units and a new research unit. "We will have state-of-the-art facilities," Jordan said. "This will enable the university to obtain grant funds for research and

to attract the best faculty and graduate students. We also want to attract more undergraduate students into the field of agriculture. And we believe these new facilities will help us," Jordan said.

The three-day convention program had a list of other speakers that included Daniel Schorr, honored journalist and William Colby, former CIA director. The slate of new officers for the association includes: President Arthur McAlistler; Jack Dreibelbis, first vice president; John Sutton, second vice president; Janet Hines, third vice president; Jack Hess, treasurer; John Keyes, George Kishbaugh, James Bradley and Tom Brown, board of directors. 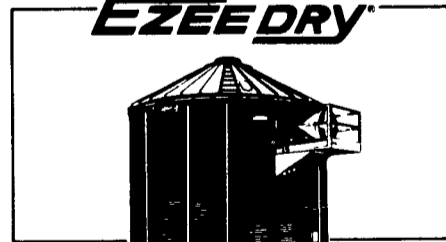
