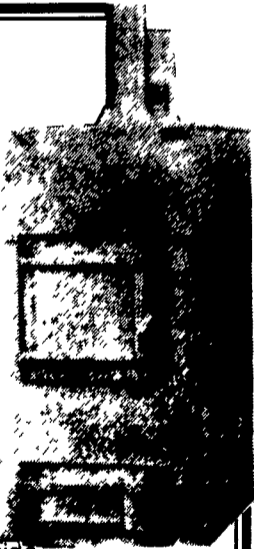
Also presenting an analysis of the national economy is Robert M.

ation for Eastern farmers and for the security of our employees," Donovan said. "But our growth and profit potential were hampered at critical times by the lack of milk licenses." Donovan explained that the co-op had planned to distribute fluid milk to retail outlets in 19 upstate New York counties, but that its request for licenses had been denied by the state Department of Agriculture and Markets.

Despite that, he said, the co-op had managed to sell milk to licensed distributors in a number of counties, and went on to obtain licenses in six counties, primarily by buying out smaller dairies.

In the wake of the recent court ruling opening up New York State to outside competition, and continuing delays on reconsidering Eastern's license request, Donovan said, "we decided we couldn't wait any longer because of our

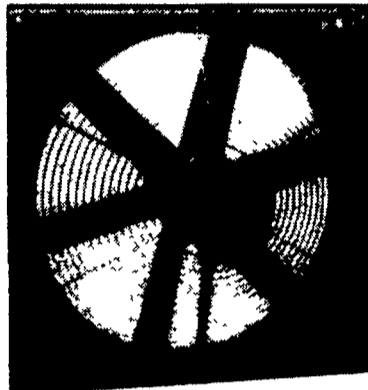
responsibility to our member farmers. We could not afford to operate this processing facility at a loss."

The general manager also stated that productivity at the plant had been hampered by the union's unwillingness in last year's negotiations to make necessary work rule changes.

Donovan said he expected DairyLea to hire some of the employees, and that Eastern would work with the remaining workers to help them locate other employment.
