ACRES WHEAT UPDATE: Wheat futures closed lower today, close to session lows, in a late selloff tied to long liquidation. News that Morocco's secound round of bids for export bonus wheat had been rejected in addition to the absence of China's export bonus tender put wheat on the defensive throughout today's session. Continuing reports of USSR harvest

problems limited further losses. The Dec. option posted a 4-1/4 cent loss, settling at \$2.92-1/2, which is below our last support of \$2.93.

#### ACRES CATTLE UPDATE:

Live cattle and feeder cattle futures mixed this afternoon, with losses in the front months and gains in the deferreds. Selling in the nearby months was spurred by the premium which October holds to cash cattle prices as first notice day

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
