



FUTURES MARKET TRENDS GRAIN AND LIVESTOCK

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ACRES WHEAT UPDATE: Wheat futures closed higher and made new contract highs in three 1988 contracts on concerns over dry weather in major wheat area of the Pacific northwest. Support early was linked to the rally of corn and soybeans but later ideas of possible Indian interest entered the market. Nearterm resistance

remains at the \$3.15 level.

ACRES CATTLE UPDATE: Live cattle and feeder cattle futures closed lower, pressured by cash connected selling. Prices were also pressured by a short term over-bought condition. Carcass and box beef trade was steady as were cash cattle leading some traders to continue their bullish outlook. The other side notices hea-

vier out-weights and the lack of product price improvement to stage a strong rally. Feeders were pressured by lower trending cash prices and higher grains. CME FEEDER CATTLE SETTLEMENT PRICE: 10/12/87 \$77.17 dn \$.13 ACRES NEXT DAY OUTLOOK: cash - steady futures-steady to lower

ACRES HOG UPDATE: Live hog futures closed lower on sharp losses in the belly pit. Numerous sell-stops were activated just before the close in Feb. bellies. Weakening fundamentals include higher weights, higher slaughter and expanded product supplies. Harvest is causing delays in marketing complicating the problems with demand.

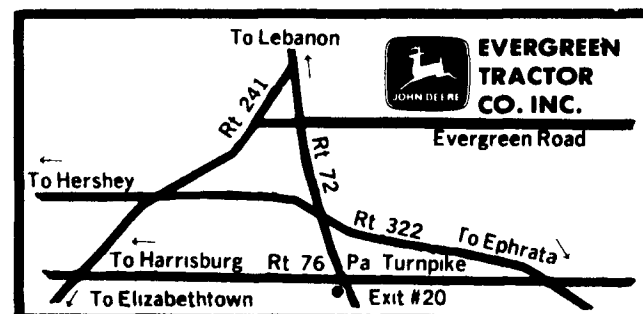
