

Number Down At ROV Angus Show

TIMONIUM, MD. — Although the number of cattle at the Roll of Victory (ROV) Angus Show was down at this year's 1987 Eastern National Livestock Show held here, the quality of the cattle was up. The 63-head competing were judged by Steve Weaver, Peoria, Ill.

Dameron Linedrive, a May 1985 son of Ken Caryl Overdrive 304H, captured the title of grand champion bull. Also named the senior winner, he is owned by Jeff Dameron, Lexington, Ill.; Premier Angus Inc., Cloverdale, Ind.; B L C Angus Ranch, Tecumseh, Ok.; and Riverside Farms, Hamilton, Texas.

An April 1985, Cobble Pond New Yorker son stood as the reserve grand champion bull for William Warren, Furlong; Genetics Unlimited Inc., West Grove, Chester Co.; and G H 2 Angus Associates, York, York Co., of Pennsylvania. Genetics Madison Avenue earlier won the reserve senior champion ribbon.

Premier Angus Inc. teamed up with Riverside Farms and exhibited the grand champion female at the ROV show. Class Act R F is a January 1986 daughter of Harrison, and she was also named the junior champion female.

Another Harrison daughter, born March 1986 was declared the reserve junior and reserve grand

champion female. Hilary is owned by Fairfield Farms and J&D Hough, both of Lakeville, Ct.

Genetics Unlimited Inc. lined up progeny by Genetics Yukon Jack and won both the get and junior get-of-sire classes.

Lee Miller & Family, Woodsboro, Md., showed the junior champion bull. He is Mar Lee Challenger 622. The reserve junior champion bull title went to Genetics Goliath. He is owned by Genetics Unlimited Inc.

Tradition 6026 of GH2, owned by G H 2 Angus Associates, claimed the intermediate champion bull ribbon. This group of breeders Huntingdon Farm, Alexandria; James Moxley & Son, West Friendship, Md.; and Jolt Associates, West Friendship, exhibited the reserve intermediate champion bull, H F Jolt 623.

Premier Angus Inc. led out the senior bull calf winner, Premier Jolt.

Junior bull calf champion honors went to Fairfield Dark Star P57. He was shown by Fairfield Farms. Spring Mill Farm, West Friendship, Md., exhibited the reserve junior bull calf winner, Spring Mill Fairway.

The senior yearling champion female was Mar Lee Sweetness, and she was shown by Lee Miller & Family.

Rhonda Long, Sherwood,

Maryland, owns the intermediate champion female. She is Destinations Lively Lady. The reserve intermediate champion female, C K Lucys Sable is owned by Greg Krueger and Family, Coatesville, Chester Co.; Bill Conley, Clarksdale, Mo.; and Richard Gregg, New Providence.

Premier Miss Regal 7858B was presented the senior heifer calf ribbon. She is owned by Premier Angus Inc. and Riverside Farms. The reserve senior heifer calf winner was Byrnley Black Queen. She was exhibited by T&J Farms, Dover, York Co., and John Hausner, The Plains, Va.

Junior heifer calf champion laurels went to Fairfield Valerie T17. Her owner is Fairfield Farms. Hidden Springs Angus, Coatesville, Chester Co., and Genetics Unlimited Inc. displayed the reserve junior heifer calf champion. She is Kinannie 406W of G U.
