Individual tickets to the event are priced at \$15. Half a table (eight places) may be reserved for \$110, and a full table for 16 at \$210.

A highlight of the banquet each year is the recognition of new "Century Farm Families." To qualify as a Century Farm, the farm must be owned by the same family for 100 consecutive years to the date of application, and a family member must currently live on the farm. The farm must consist of at least 10 acres of the original holding or gross more than \$1,000 annually from the sale of farm products.

The purpose of the Century Farms Program, initiated by the Department of Agriculture as a Bicentennial project, is to emphasize

the contributions of the family farm to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

He has served as state director of the Pennsylvania Farmers Association, a member of the board of trustees of The Pennsylvania State University, president of the Westmoreland County Farmers Association, president of the Westmoreland County Cooperative Extension Service, and chairman of the

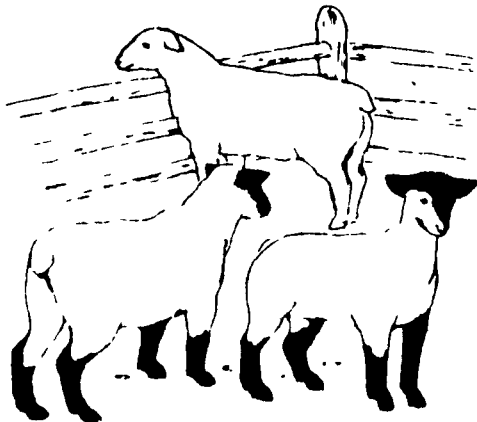
