awards for the county were also presented during the 4-H recognition program.

In the 2-year-old category, Tim Warner took both milk and fat awards, with an entry for a lactation beginning at 2 years, 1 month, 305 days in milk, 20,280 pounds of milk, 3.5 percent test, and 709 pounds fat.

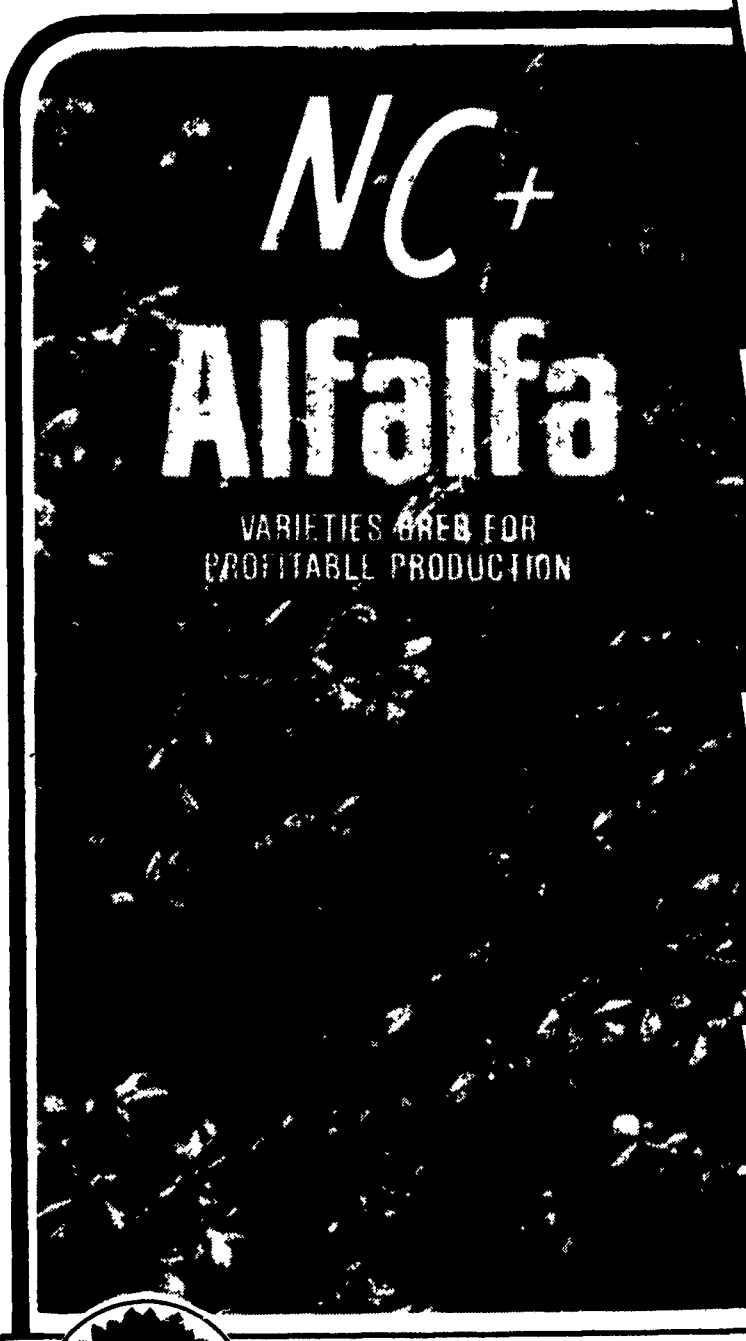
Jenelle Boyer's entry took both awards in the three-year-old division, with a lactation at 3-0, 305-days, 21,950 milk, 3.5 percent test, and 773 fat. Four-year-old category winner was Tim Warner, with a lactation at 4-11, 305-days, 23,691 milk, 3.8 percent test, 897 fat.

Milk and fat awards in the five-year-old class were split. Dana Doll claimed the high milk production honors with a lactation entry beginning at 5-2, 305-days, 26,583 milk. Fat production recognition

went to C.E. Hubbard, for a 5-10 lactation, 305-days, 1156 fat.

Dairy teams which represented York County at 4-H state competition earned recognition as well. Members of the Dairy Judging team were Matt Reheard, who placed eighth high in the state, Scott Barr, Anita Emig and Crystal Emig. Dairy bowl team members were Angie Lang, Bridgette Boyer, Rich Bupp and Tim Warner.

Additional awards were presented to members who exhibited the breed champions during the annual 4-H Dairy Roundup. Champion exhibitors were: C.E. Hubbard, Holstein; Kimberly McCleary, Jersey and Brown Swiss; and Kelly Morris, Guernsey. Showmanship and fitting champions named were C.E. Hubbard, senior division, Jenelle Boyer, intermediate, and Brad Walker, junior.
