2 cups flour
1 teaspoon baking soda
$1 / 4$ cup milk


2 cups chopped fresh apple Mix all ingredients together. Drop by small spoonfuls on ungreased cookie sheets. Bake at 400 degrees for 10-12 minutes or until cookies are firm when touched but not overly brown. Glaze:
1 tablespoon melted butter 1 cup powdered sugar Stir before adding: $1 / 4$ teaspoon maple flavoring 2-3 tablespoons milk
Dot the top of each cookie with $1 / 2$ teaspoon of glaze. Cool. Allow glazed cookies to dry before storing in airtight container.
