
½ cup butter 1 cup brown sugar Dash of salt 1 teaspoon cinnamon ¼ teaspoon nutmeg ground corianda

2 cups flour 1 teaspoon baking soda

1/4 cup milk

1 tablespoon melted butter 1 cup powdered sugar Stir before adding:

1/4 teaspoon maple flavoring 2-3 tablespoons milk

Dot the top of each cookie with ½ teaspoon of glaze. Cool. Allow glazed cookies to dry before storing in airtight container.
