

# MICROWAVE

Melt butter in heat-resistant, microwave-safe, 2-quart bowl or casserole. Stir in sugar and milk. Clip microwave candy thermometer on container edge, so tip is into candy mixture but not touching container bottom. Cover with plastic wrap. (Slit plastic wrap around top of microwave candy thermometer to keep it cool enough to handle.) Microwave (High) 2 minutes. Stir to dissolve sugar. Microwave (High), uncovered, 3 1/2 to 5 minutes, stirring after 1 1/2

minutes. Candy is done when microwave candy thermometer registers 235-237 F (soft-ball stage). Remove microwave candy thermometer. Add chocolate chips, marshmallows, and vanilla, stirring with wooden spoon, until smooth. Stir in nuts. Pour into waxed paper-lined 8x4 loaf pan. When cool, remove, wrap tightly and store in cool place or in freezer. Cut before serving. Makes 3/4 pound.

Note: Recipe may be doubled.

Use a deep 2-quart measure. Double all ingredients. Double minimum cooking times, adding more time as necessary for mixture to reach 235 F. Pour into a prepared 8 or 9-inch square pan.

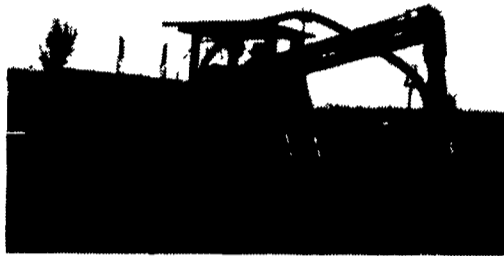
Recipes in this column are tested in 600- and 650-watt microwave ovens. With an oven of different wattage output, timings may need slight adjustment.

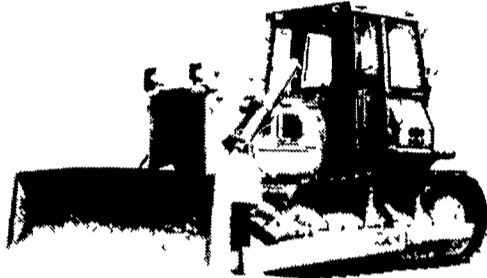

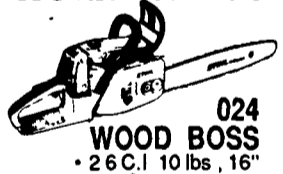

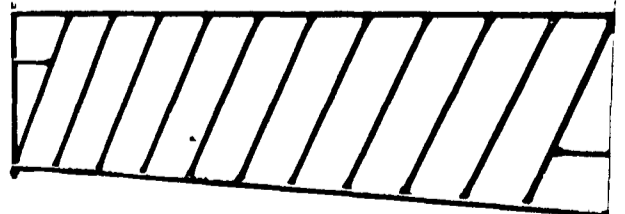
