

Watusi Cow Brings \$11,000 At Sale

HEBRON, ND — "Kathy", a magnificent horned, five-year-old Foundation Pure Watusi cow bred by Catskill Game Farm, Catskill, NY and consigned by J.C. Schulz,

Catskill, NY commanded a price of \$11,000 to top the Annual Fall Watusi Sale sanctioned by the World Watusi Association and held in conjunction with the 5-H

Ranch Exotic Animal Auction, Cape Girardeau, MO on October 17, 1987. Buyer was A. C. Parsons, Texas Safari Wildlife Park, Clifton, TX who is fast acquiring a

specimen herd of these sleek and stately, huge-horned, African cows known as "The Cattle of Kings" and desired in the U.S. for novelty, prestige, rarity, show and crossbred for rodeo use and low cholesterol, lean beef.

Second high selling Foundation Pure Watusi at \$6,500 came on "Sparky" a 2 year old heifer, also bred by Catskill Game Farm, consigned by J.C. Schulz, Catskill, NY and taken home by Jerry Hagee, Arbuckle Wilderness, Edmond, OK.

In the percentage blood category sale toppers were "J B Whitney" 3/4 blood yearling heifer consigned by Jean Bonds, Phoenix, AZ and "Bambi", 1/2 blood heifer consigned by John & Robyn Goodin of Charleston, MO. These colorful, top horned individuals were marked off at \$1,700 each to new owner, Delbert Eichelberger of Pryor, OK.

Thirty-four buyers from 18 states successfully bid to become owners of the 97 head of Watusi and percentage Watusi offered at this sale.

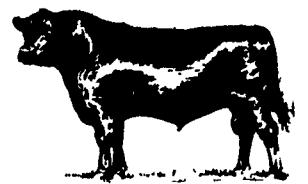

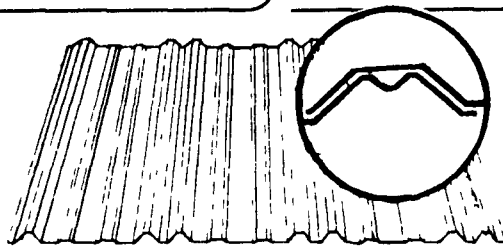

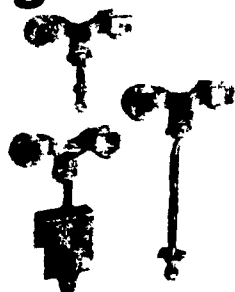
