Phillips, who is in partnership with her husband David, owns 100 acres and raises a herd of 50 Jerseys and approximately 40

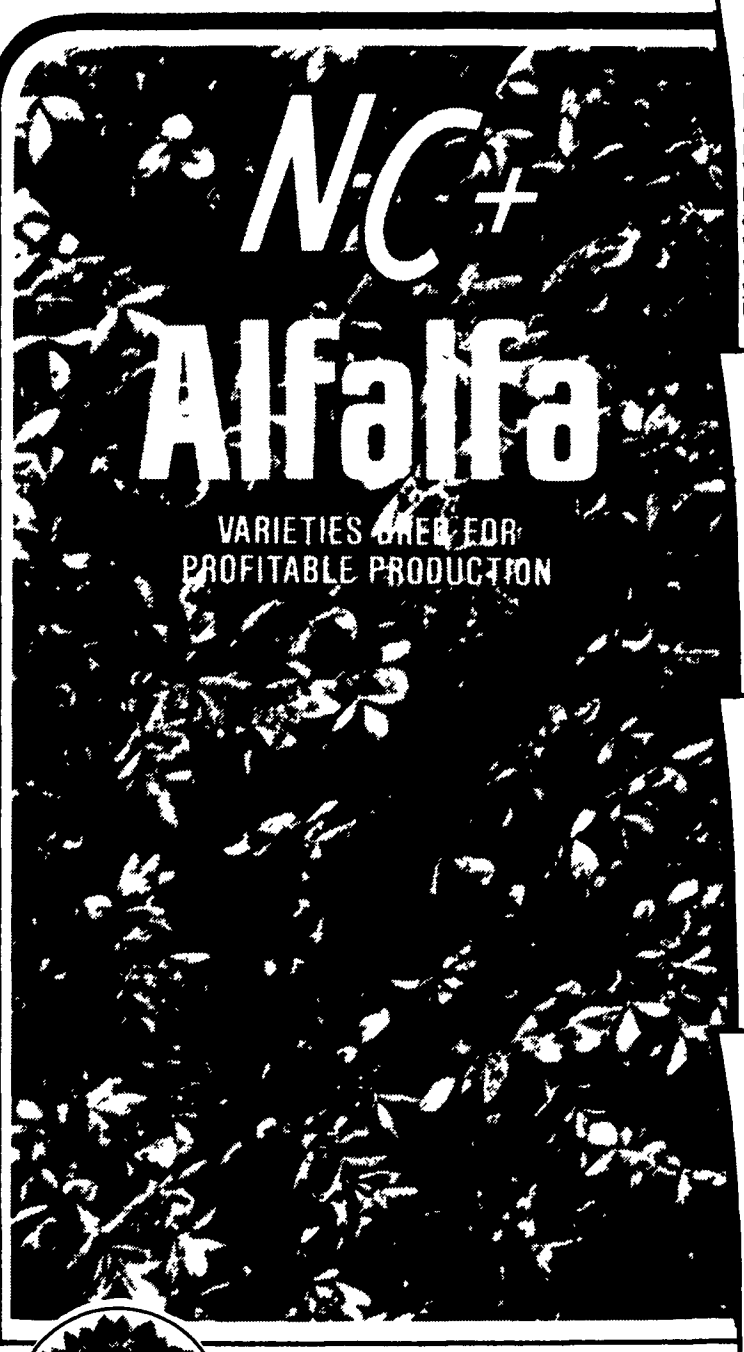
young stock.

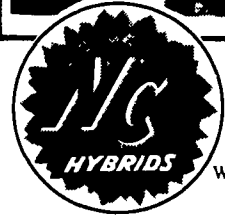
