CASH GRAINS AND SOYBEANS CLOSED MIXED. WHEAT MARKETS UNCHANGED TO SLIGHTLY LOWER. LACK OF FOLLOW THROUGH TRADING ON EBP BIDDING WEAKENED MARKET PRICES. CORN MARKETS FIRMER ON USDA'S ANNOUNCEMENT THE CORN AUCTION WILL NOT BE NECESSARY AND STRONG EXPORT LINEUP. SOYBEANS CLOSED HIGHER SUPPORTED BY A WEAKER U.S. DOLLAR AND ACTIVE PROCESSOR DEMAND.

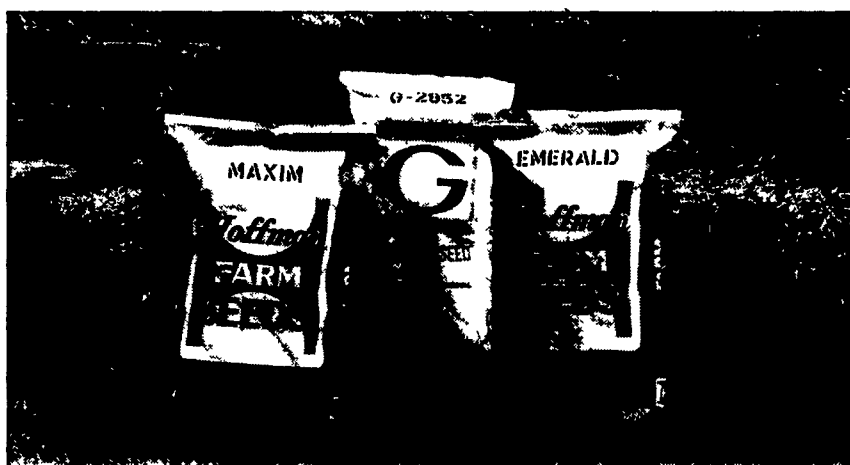
