Special Awards were presented at the State level to blue form winners in a number of categories. Winning Keystone Awards this past year were Jeanne Smith in

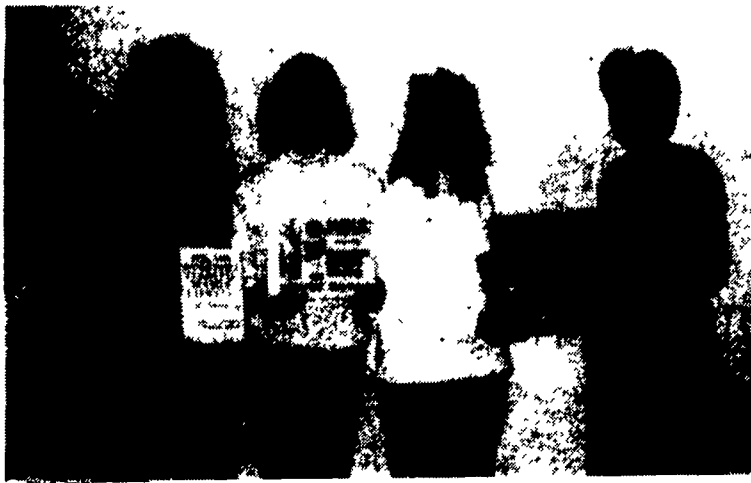
Citizenship and Leadership, Janet Ludwig as Outstanding Member,

Holiday Food Mailing Tips

WAYNE CO. — Surprise far away friends and relatives with a gift from your kitchen. To be sure your gift arrives in good condition be sure to consider these points before selecting recipes to make.

* Food needs to stay fresh for at least 2 weeks.

* Food needs to be sturdy enough to withstand rough treatment.

* Cookies that travel best are drop, bar, or semi-moist fruit varieties. Crisp cookies crumble.

* Very moist cookies or cakes may mold.

* Avoid soft icings or open faced jam fillings.

* Food needs to be packed in unbreakable containers rather than glass jars. Choose a strong metal, plastic, or cardboard container just large enough for your gift.

* Even the sturdiest foods require careful packing to prevent crumbling.

* Mail early. Your gift will arrive sooner and have less chance of being lost. Your friends and relatives can start enjoying your homemade goodies right away, while they are at their best.

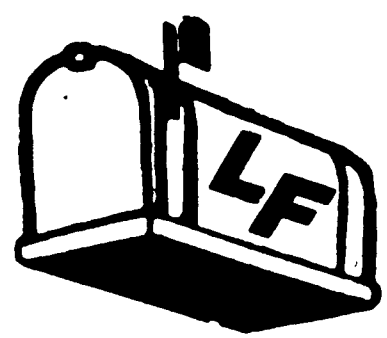
