NATIONAL GRAIN MARKET SUMMARY \*\*INDICATES CHANGE COMPARED TO MONDAY'S PRICES. LOWER PRICES FOR CASH GRAINS AND SOYBEANS CONTINUED WEDNESDAY. FUTURES TRADING ALSO LOWER DESPITE CONTINUED GOOD EXPORT DEMAND.

A SNOW STORM MOVED EASTWARD INTO THE MIDWEST AFTER DUMPING UP TO A FOOT OF SNOW SEVERAL PLACES IN THE SOUTHWEST EARLIER IN THE WEEK. MAJOR HIGHWAYS CLOSED AND MOVEMENT OF GRAINS AND LIVESTOCK CAME TO A HALT. SOYBEAN PRICES SHOWING THE MOST DECLINE WEDNESDAY AND AS MUCH AS 8 CENTS LOWER TO CENTRAL ILLINOIS PROCESSORS.
