For Somerset DHIA

SOMERSET — New directors were elected in Somerset County DHIA to three-year terms: Harry Mosholder, Rt. 2, Rockwood; and Allen Baer, Rt. 3, Somerset. Approximately 230 persons attended the annual meeting and banquet of the Somerset County dairy Herd Improvement Association held November 24 at the Berlin Community Building.

Annual Somerset County Milk, butterfat and protein production awards were received by the following:

Highest Herd Average For Milk Per Cow — 25,332 lbs., North View Farm, Rt. 1, Berlin

Highest Herd Average For Milkfat per cow — 896 lbs. Harry Mosholder, Rt. 2, Rockwood.

Highest Herd Average For Protein per Cow — 803 lbs., North View Farm, Rt. 1, Berlin

Highest Individual Cow Record For Milk — 34,787 lbs.,

North View Farm, Berlin.

Highest Individual Cow Record For Milkfat — 1,278 lbs., Harry Mosholder, Rockwood.

Highest Individual Cow Record For Protein — 1,074 lbs., North View Farm, Berlin

Lowest Herd Somatic Cell Count Average — 103,000, Blough Brothers, Boswell.

A brief reorganizational meeting of the directors was held following the conclusion of the annual meeting. Elected President was Bradwin Winters, Rt. 1, Friedens, Vice-president Harry Mosholder, Rt. 2, Rockwood, and Secretary-Treasurer Leroy Bittner, Rt. 4, Meyersdale.

The county ranked tenth in the state in milk production at 17,166 lbs., while the state average was below at 16,585 lbs. Somerset ranked seventh statewide in butterfat per cow at 633 lbs. Income over feed costs rose from \$1,146 in 1986 to \$1,306 in 1987.



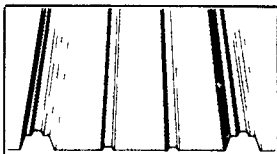

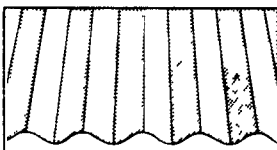
