My most memorable Christmas was in "85" when my grandmother was in a tragic accident a week before Christmas eve.




That Saturday my parents took my sister and me up to the hospital to visit grandmother. Her hands were bruised badly and her back was in a brace to aid her spinal cord in healing.


Every Christmas Eve my cousins, my uncle, our grandparents and our family get together, but this year our hearts were shattered because grandma would be spending Christmas in the hospital.


