MARKETS IN REVIEW; JANUARY 7-13, 1988. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA AUCTION SOLD STEADY TO \$3.00 HIGHER WHILE MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS WERE STEADY AT VIRGINIA AUCTIONS WHILE MIDWEST MARKETS WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER. BOXED BEEF PRICES WERE \$31 HIGHER LAST WEEK AS THE BOXED BEEF CUT-OUT VALUE REACHED \$102.43/CWT. WEDNESDAY.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA AUCTIONS WERE MIXED, \$3.00 LOWER TO \$2.00 HIGHER WHILE MIDWEST PRICES WERE MIXED, \$4.00 LOWER TO \$2.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION LAST WEEK WAS 13% ABOVE THE PREVIOUS WEEK AND 10% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 8 LBS. LIGHTER THAN LAST YEAR.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA AUCTIONS WERE STEADY LAST WEEK, FOLLOWING MIDWEST PRICES WHICH WERE STEADY TO WEAK. SLAUGHTER WAS 26% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 12% BELOW A YEAR AGO AS AVERAGE WEIGHTS WERE 5 LBS. HEAVIER

THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES AT VIRGINIA AUCTIONS WERE \$2.00-3.00 HIGHER LAST WEEK AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$8.00 HIGHER. SLAUGHTER LAST WEEK WAS 19% ABOVE THE PREVIOUS WEEK AND 3% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE WEIGHTS WERE THE SAME AS LAST YEAR.

HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA AUCTIONS WERE \$1.50 TO \$3.50 HIGHER THIS WEEK. PORK PRICES WERE LOWER DURING THE WEEK. PORK PRODUCTION LAST WEEK WAS 18% ABOVE THE PREVIOUS WEEK AND 2% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE WEIGHTS WERE 1 LB. HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.
