**ACRES CATTLE UPDATE:** Cattle futures closed sharply higher again today as late buying was attributed to the establish of new longs and position evening in front of Friday's USDA Cattle inventory report. Rumor has it that the report will show the smallest calf crop in more than 20 years. A weak undertone in the beef market with midday dressed beef prices \$2.00 lower trimmed further advances in the futures markets. Feeders followed live cattle as the buying spirit became infectious. March feeders posted a high of \$80.25 and settled at \$80.17, up 25 points. **CME FEEDER CATTLE SETTLEMENT PRICE:** 01/29/88 \$81.69 dn \$ .14. **ACRES NEXT DAY OUT-LOOK:** cash -steady lower futures-steady.

**ACRES HOG UPDATE:** Live hog futures closed mixed today with front months closing from 7 points higher to 8 points lower. Ideas that cash openings tomorrow would be lower pressured futures as improved weather conditions

made for better driving conditions. Prices were further stressed by ideas that packer margins were deteriorating along with an increase in numbers. Bellies closed higher but off session highs with buying attributed to oversold conditions.

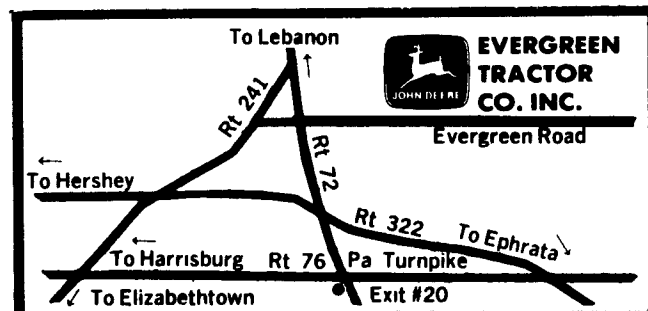
