Beacon Forage Management Seminar Held

INTERCOURSE — A forage management seminar for farmers by the Beacon Milling Company was held here Tuesday to discuss the technics of mowing, conditioning, baling and storing of hay.

Dick Fuller, consumer products manager for Kemin Industries, said farmers are not here to produce forages, they want to produce milk and meat. "The farmer will not stay in business long today if he cannot get full feed value from his own forages," Fuller said. "To do this, he needs to get all of his hay, including leaves, into the animals in as near the condition it was grown in the fields as possible. You could produce more milk with leaf retention and earlier cutting," Fuller said. Milk production out of the field is increasing digestable energy, protein and dry matter." "In grains, we are interested in

reducing molds and also reducing energy loss from heating," Fuller said. "This is how the farmer can make money."

Stablizers improve palatability and digestability, according to Fuller. Organic acids similar to those used in commercial feeds and foods for human consumption resist spoilage and heating. These compounds also are similar to those in the digestive systems of livestock. Trade names for the Beacon hay stablizers are New Cut Hay Preserve and Hay Preserve IV.


