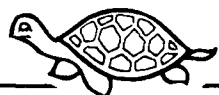

There will also be junior activities following the Friday night dinner.



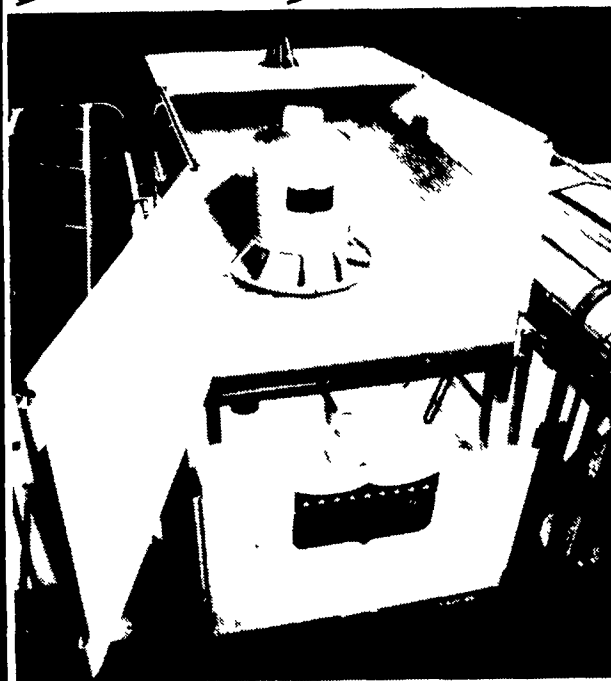
