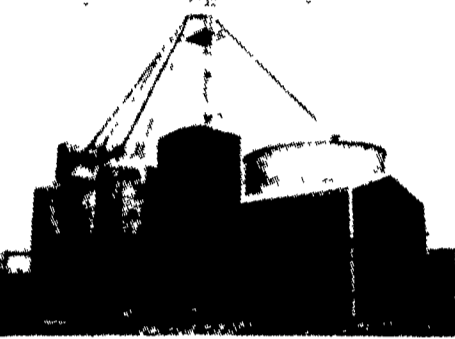
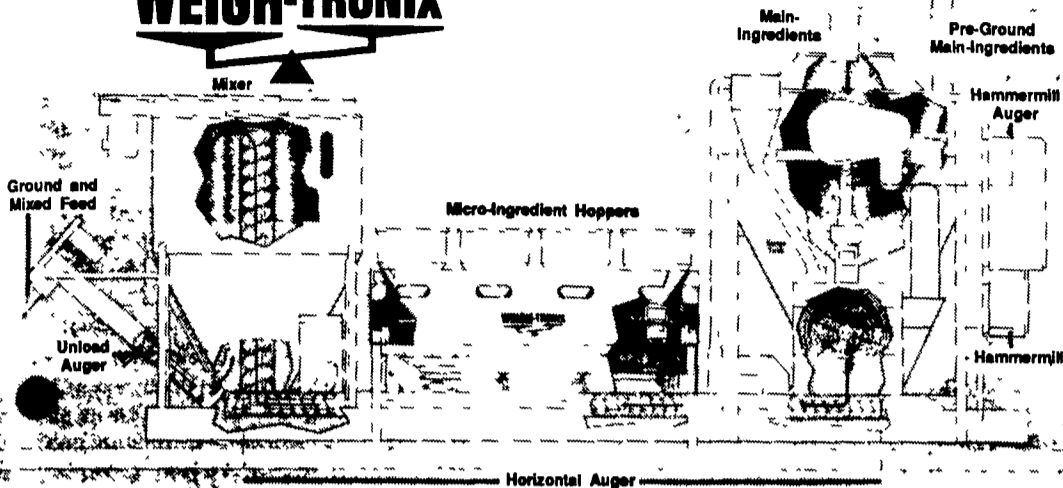

Like its Big Brothers, this "88" crushes, harrows and conditions the soil in one pass for better seedbed and bigger yields. It has all the features of other "M" series Pulvi-Mulchers. Separate levers control depth of each of two rows of spring teeth. May be equipped with notched or Crowfoot rollers, with conventional spring teeth or vibrating "S" tines.

The Brillion Pulvi-Mulcher crushes both surface and buried lumps finishes and firms the seedbed in one operation converts fall or spring plowings into clod-free seedbeds. 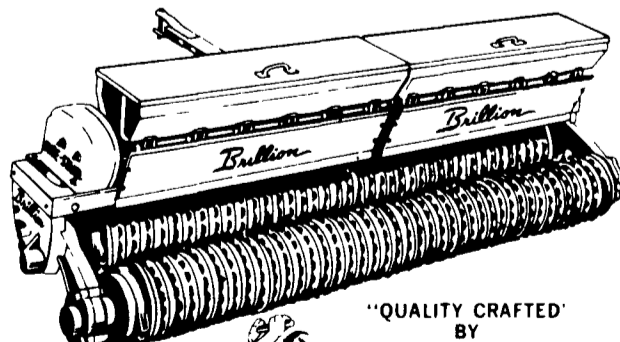
