CASH GRAINS AND SOYBEANS MIXED. WHEAT MARKETS HIGHER SUPPORTED BY STRONG EXPORT DEMAND. BASIS LEVELS HELD UNCHANGED ADDING STRENGTH WITH U.S.D.A.'S ANNOUNCEMENT OF AN ADDITIONAL 500,000 TONNES OF WHEAT OFFERED TO POLAND UNDER EEP AND U.S.S.R.'S TENDER FOR 500,000 TONNES HARD RED WINTER WHEAT. CORN MARKETS LOWER DUE TO HEAVY MARCH DELIVERIES AND WEAKENING DEMAND RESULTING IN LOWER BASIS LEVELS. SOYBEANS DECLINED SLIGHTLY ON WEAKER CRUSHER DEMAND AND LOWER EXPORT MEAL MARKETS.

EXPORT NEWS: HONDURAS BOUGHT 93,000 TONNES OF WHEAT UNDER PL480 FOR APRIL-SEPT DELIVERY WEST AFRICAN COUNTRIES BOUGHT 27,500 TONNES OF NORTHERN/DARK NORTHERN SPRING WHEAT FOR APRIL/MAY DELIVERY. USDA TARGETED POLAND FOR AN ADDITIONAL 500,000 TONNES OF U.S. EXPORT BONUS WHEAT. U.S.S.R. TENDERING TODAY FOR 500,000 TONNES U.S. HARD RED WINTER WHEAT FOR MAY SHIPMENT. EGYPT BOUGHT 145,000 TONNES OF U.S. CORN FOR DELIVERY DURING THE 1987-88 MARKETING YEAR. YUGOSLAVIA BOUGHT 15,000 TONNES OF U.S. SOYMEAL FOR NEARBY SHIPMENT.
