CASH GRAINS AND SOYBEANS MIXED. WHEAT MARKETS CONTINUE TO RECEIVE SUPPORT FROM STRONG EXPORT TRADING WITH INDICATIONS CHINA AND INDIA WOULD ENTER THE MARKET LATER THIS WEEK FOR FURTHER PURCHASES. CORN AND SOYBEANS SLIGHTLY LOWER PRESSURED BY SLIGHTLY IMPROVED MOISTURE CONDITIONS IN THE UPPER MIDWEST.

EXPORT NEWS: KENYA BOUGHT 39,100 TONNES OF U.S. NO. 2 OR BETTER HARD RED WINTER WHEAT FOR MAY SHIPMENT. EGYPT TODAY RECEIVED A PL480 PURCHASE AUTHORIZATION FOR ABOUT 200,000 TONNES OF U.S. WHEAT FOR APRIL-SEPT DELIVERY. ALGERIA WAS TARGETED FOR THE SALE OF 200,000 TONNES BARLEY UNDER EBP. TUNISIA WILL TENDER THURSDAY FOR 33,000 TONNES U.S. SOYMEAL FOR MAY/JUNE SHIPMENT.
