"An equally important reason for offering the 5-year/5,000-hour warranty is the MAGNUM tractors' exceptional reliability, resulting from their advanced design and manufacturing. The new warranty documents the company's confidence in the MAGNUM line's

covers all parts except tires, according to Case IH officials.

reliability," Miller added.

"Thousands of hours of laboratory and field testing confirm the reliability of the MAGNUM line," Miller said.

The warranty coverage applies to all of the 14,000-plus parts on the MAGNUM tractors. Only the tires, which are covered by tire manufacturers' warranties, are excluded.

The 5-year/5,000-hour coverage provides no-charge, warranty service for dealer labor and parts

replacement during the first year.

the fifth year, the plan pays war-

the fifth year, the plan pays warranty service charges after a \$200 deductible is paid by the customer. If a customer sells a tractor, the warranty is transferable.

The warranty applies to all MAGNUM tractors including those already sold and being used by farmers.

This coverage applies to Model 7110 at 130 PTO horsepower, Model 7120 at 150 PTO horse-

power, Model 7130 at 170 PTO horsepower and Model 7140 at 195 PTO horsepower. All four models are row-crop two-wheel-drive tractors with optional mechanical-front-drive.


"Case IH believes the market will react extremely favorably to this warranty," Miller said. "The MAGNUM line has generated a great deal of interest in the North American market, and this warranty should just be the icing on the cake."



When the unit is disconnected from the vacuum line, it is kept in the retracted position by a patented cord lock. This feature eliminates the need for hanging the milking claw on the take-off unit before moving to the next cow.
