

## Shoener Wins Pennsylvania Agricultural Safety Award Council

UNIVERSITY PARK (Centre). — J. Allan Shoener, a Schuylkill County extension agent on the staff of Penn State Cooperative Extension, received an award from the Pennsylvania Agricultural

Safety Council for his contributions to farm safety programs. He was presented with his award at the Council's eleventh annual meeting in State College, Pa. on March 22. Over the past six years, Shoener,

who is a leader in developing agricultural safety programs, organized and conducted more than 10 farm accident workshops throughout Schuylkill County. These

instructional programs focused on grain storage safety, manure pit accidents, silo fires and rescue procedures. He also led workshops on toxic gas and chemical fire safety for local volunteer fire companies and rescue crews. His most recent workshop focused on farm acci-

dent rescue procedures for the Bloomsburg Hospital's emergency rescue teams.

Shoener, a Penn State graduate in animal science, has been with the Schuylkill County extension service since 1977. He lives with his family in Pine Grove, Pa.
