Maryland Dairy Bowl

With half of their members owning goats instead of cows, Montgomery County 4-H teams swept top honors in both the senior and junior divisions of the 13th annual state 4-H dairy bowl knowledge contest held at the University

of Maryland. This year's victory was the second consecutive championship for a Montgomery County Senioer 4-H team. The winning group is now eligible to represent Maryland in a national 4-H dairy quiz con-

test. This event is normally held in early November during the North American International Livestock Exposition in Kentucky.

Lisa Burdett, 19, of South Germantown, and Susan Knapp, 17, of Goshen, were members of last year's winning Montgomery County team, which placed eighth in the national contest. Lisa and Susan were coaches for the 1988 state champion junior and senior

Lisa's brother, D.j. Burdette, 14, was a member of this year's state champion senior 4-H dairy bowl team. Other members were Krissie Smith, 17, of Gaithersburg, and Donna Johnson, 16, of Damascus.






