SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS AT VIRGINIA AUCTIONS WERE \$2.00-3.50 HIGHER THIS WEEK AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO 50 CENT HIGHER. THE BEEF CUT-OUT VALUE ON TUESDAY WAS \$112.71 THIS WAS \$1.02 ABOVE LAST WEEK

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA **AUCTION LAST WEEK WERE MOST-**LY STEADY TO \$2.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 4 PERCENT ABOVE THE PREVI-**OUS WEEK AND 10 PERCENT ABOVE** A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 17 POUNDS HEA-VIER THAN LAST YEAR.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 LOWER LAST WEEK IN VIRGINIA AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE WEAK. CALF PRODUC-TION LAST WEEK WAS 9 PERCENT BELOW THE PREVIOUS WEEK AND 17 PERCENT BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 4 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN LAST

LAMBS PRICES AT VIRGINIA AUC-TIONS WERE MOSTLY STEADY TO \$3.00 LOWER LAST WEEK AS MID-WEST PRICES WERE \$4,00-7,00 LOW-ER. PRODUCTION WAS 3 PERCENT BELOW THE WEEK BEFORE BUT 23 PERCENT ABOVE A YEAR EARLIER. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST
