SPECULATION ABOUT THE YARDS IS THAT NEXT WEEK'S RUN COULD BE SIZEABLE. QUALITY OF FEEDER CATTLE SUPPLY, THOUGH ADEQUATE FOR TREND DECISIONS, WAS CONSIDERABLY PLAINER THAN ANYTIME SINCE END OF APRIL.
