MARKETS IN REVIEW; JUNE 2-8, 1988. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA LAST WEEK WERE \$1.00-3.00 LOWER WHILE MIDWEST PRICES WERE 50 CENT TO \$3.50 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.25-2.75 HIGHER LAST WEEK AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE 50 CENT HIGHER. THE BOXED BEEF CUT-OUT VALUE ON TUESDAY WAS \$115.96, DOWN \$1.10 FROM LAST TUESDAY.

COWS AND BULLS AT VIRGINIA AUCTIONS WERE MOSTLY \$1.00-3.00 LOWER WHILE MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUC-TION WAS 19 PERCENT LOWER THAN A WEEK AGO AND 16 PERCENT LOWER THAN LAST YEAR. AVER-AGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 15 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGI-NIA LAST WEEK WERE STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$2.00 LOW-ER. VEAL AND CALF SLAUGHTER WAS 13 PERCENT BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 25 PERCENT BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 12 POUNDS HEA-VIER THAN LAST YEAR.

LAMBS PRICES AT VIRGINIA AUC-TIONS LAST WEEK WERE STEADY TO \$6.00 LOWER WHILE MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$2.00-4.00 LOWER. SLAUGHTER WAS 17 PERCENT BELOW LAST WEEK AND 13 PER-CENT BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVER-AGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 6 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

SLAUGHTER HOGS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY \$1.00-1.25 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE 25-75 CENT LOWER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE 50 CENT TO \$10 00 LOWER LAST WEEK. PORK PRODUCTION WAS 14 PERCENT BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 4 PERCENT BELOW LAST YEAR AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.
