FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS UNDER 600 LB. 3.00-5.00 LOWER WITH AN INCREASED OFFERING OF NEW CROP CALVES AROUND 10.00 LOWER. TRENDS HARD TO PEG ON THESE CALVES JUST OFF COWS AT THE BEGINNING OF THEIR MARKETING SEASON BUT DRY WEATHER, APPROACHING SUMMER MONTHS, AND WHEAT HARVEST IN FULL PROGRESS HAS OUTLETS VERY NARROW. SLAUGHTER COWS 3.00-5.00 LOWER, MOSTLY 4.00-5.00 OFF. SLAUGHTER BULLS 3.00-5.00 LOWER, MOSTLY 3.00-4.00 OFF. LARGER RUN THAN ANTICIPATED THIS WEEK. LACK OF RAINFALL IN SOME AREAS, BOTH IN OKLAHOMA AND ON A NATIONAL BASIS RESULTING IN AN INCREASE IN NUMBERS OF CALVES, LIGHT YEARLINGS AND COWS; OUTLETS ALSO RESTRICTED AS BUYERS TAKE INVENTORY OF FEED SUPPLIES AND ANTICIPATED OR PROJECTED FEED COSTS. 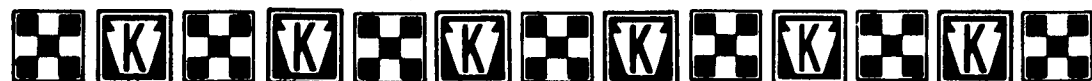

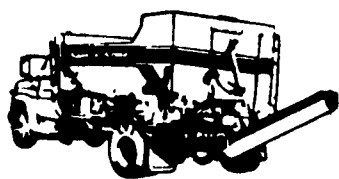

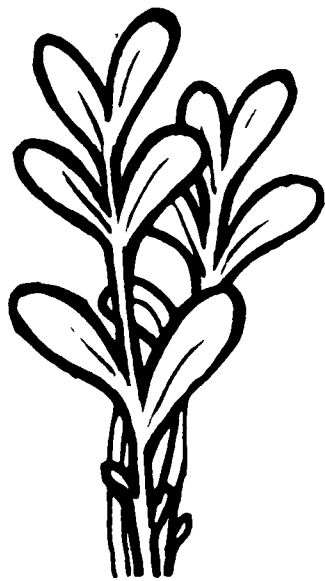
