SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00 TO \$4.75 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-2.00 LOWER. THE BOXED BEEF **CUT-OUT VALUE ON TUESDAY WAS** \$108.92 DOWN \$4.75 FROM LAST TUESDAY.

COWS AND BULLS AT VIRGINIA AUCTIONS LAST WEEK WERE \$5.00-9.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-2.00 LOWER **BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 2 PERCENT** BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 3 PER-CENT ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVER-AGE WEIGHTS WERE 16 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES AT VIRGI-NIA AUCTION LAST WEEK WERE STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY WITH A WEAK UNDER-TONE. VEAL AND CALF SLAUGHTER

WAS THE SAME AS THE WEEK BEFORE BUT DOWN 12 PERCENT FROM A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 18 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.


