Thursday, July 14, 1988 WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; JULY 7-13, 1988. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS VIRGINIA LAST WEEK WERE STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$3.50-7.00 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA LAST WEEK WERE \$1.25-1.50 LOWER WHILE MIDWEST PRICES WERE UNEVEN \$1.00 LOWER TO 50 CENT HIGHER. THE BOXED REEF CUT-OUT VALUE ON TUESDAY WAS \$109.13 UP \$1.10 FROM LAST TUESDAY.

COWS AND BULLS AT VIRGINIA LAST WEEK WERE MOSTLY STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$100 LOWER BEEF PRODUCT JLAST WEEK WAS 11 PERCENT BELOW THE WEEK BEFORE AND 7 PERCENT BELOW LAST YEAR. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 7 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES LAST WEEK IN VIRGINIA WERE \$5.00-14.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$3.00 LOWER. VEAL AND CALF SLAUGHTER WAS 15 PERCENT BELOW THE PREVIOUS WEEK AND 11 PERCENT BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 14 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.
