WAYNE COUNTY DHIA

Robert Fielding & Son, #5 Lake Ariel, had the leading dairy herd in the Wayne County Dairy Herd Improvement Association in the May test period, according to the Cooperative Extension Service. The herd of 31 Holsteins had a rolling herd average of 19,663 pounds of milk and 795 pounds of butterfat.

Other top herds were. Kevin Burleigh, #1 Pleasant Mount, 20,388 milk and 753 fat; Charles P Dennis, #2 Honesdale, 19,376 milk and 734 fat; Jack & Ella Chyle, Pleasant Mount, 20,919 milk and 725 fat; James Slocum, #3 Susquehanna, 17,970 milk and 693 fat, Kinghill Farm, Starrucca, 17,772 milk and 688 fat, Rowe Brothers, #2 Honesdale, 18,243 milk and 680 fat; Highland Farms, St Rt Honesdale, 19,474 milk and 673 fat; E.W. Lepro, #2 Thompson, 17,586 milk and 663 fat; and Clearfield Farms, #2 Honesdale, 17,561 milk and 657 fat.

The cow completing the highest lactation of 305 days or less during the May test period was a four year old Holstein owned by Robert Fielding & Son, #5 Lake Ariel. "Kate" produced 18,669 pounds of milk and 951 pounds of butterfat

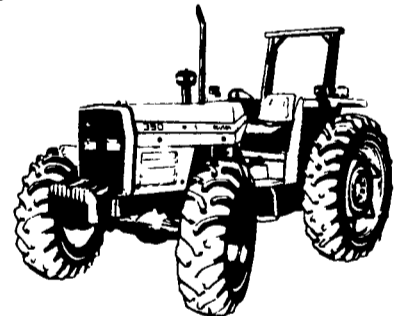
